

Even Realities REACH SVHC Disclosure

The Registration, Evaluation, Authorization, and Restriction of Chemicals Regulation EC1907/2006, commonly referred to as REACH, is a European regulation on chemicals and their safe use. With the publication of candidate lists for authorization, the European Chemicals Agency identifies sets of substances of very high concern (SVHC) that manufacturers must disclose to customers if used in articles in their products above 0.1% by weight.

Based on the current version of the candidate list for authorization, Even Realities products contain the following SVHCs above the disclosure threshold:

The SVHCs used in these products do not pose a safety risk to customers under normal use conditions.

As of December 2025, Even Realities products containing SVHCs above the disclosure threshold of 0.1% by weight in articles are submitted to ECHA's SCIP database.
